

- Hall steps and Ramp. The WDRA received confirmation from the Ontario Trillium Foundation that we were sot selected for the recent grant allocations but that we are able to apply again in August. Bob Grylls is currently working to update the file and make it even stronger so that we can ap-
- Hall and Rink Front Windows—We have also prepared an application to Farm Credit Canada for a grant available to rural communities to replace these windows
- Programming—We have submitted applications submitted to Whitewater Region to help subsidize the costs to run youth and adult programs in our community including activities like skating lessons, hockey lessons, broomball, ball hockey, pickle ball, yoga and tai chi.
