





ATTENTION WESTMEATH COMMUNITY

Please note a public access defibrillator is now available to the members of the community 24/7. This public defibrillator is part of the Renfrew County Public Assess Defibrillator Program

The defibrillator is placed in an green outdoor heated cabinet to the left of the ice machine at Kenny's Store in Westmeath. If 911 is called, the Renfrew County Dispatcher will also be able to direct the caller to the closet defibrillator if required. To access the defibrillator from the outdoor green cabinet simply undo the two latches on the right hand side of the outdoor cabinet and take the red defibrillator case. After using the defibrillator, return the defibrillator to Kenny's Store and give the defibrillator to the staff at the store. Stay tuned for upcoming public training.
