

The June 30<sup>th</sup> trip to Perth has been sold out.

New to the "Ottawa River Shoreline" page of the HWTProject: The Laurentian Ancients and their 5,000 year old archaeologic remnants; the 1613 Diaries of Samuel de Champlain and more on the Ottawa-Lake Coulonge Fur Trade scene from 1793 to 1821, have all been added to the OTTAWA RIVER SHORELINE. This help us understand the Indigenous Algonquin society through Champlain's observations of native farming, burials and lifestyle. A 2006 paper by David Croft shows the accuracy of Champlain's measurements crossing overland using Muskrat Lake and the Stogua Portage at Perretton or maybe the Winter Route at Greenwood.
