RE: Whitewater Region supports local Outdoor Rink in Westmeath

Recently, a nostalgic looking sheet of ice appeared in Westmeath ball diamond this past winter. The project was spearheaded through the Westmeath & District Recreation Association (WDRA).

Over the past few months the impacts of Covid-19 has flattened the ability for larger social gathering and get-togethers. Despite the many challenges of Covid-19, the WDRA fostered a network of volunteers to help build a community outdoor rink.

The idea was originally presented to the Township's Parks and Recreation department and accepting of the project through the Community Recreation Grant. The WDRA applied for and received \$2500.00 to build and operate an outdoor rink for residents to enjoy.

Michael La Grotta, WDRA Program Coordinator said "Much thanks to the Township and the time and attention giving to this endeavor. It is with the continued support from our municipality that we are able to fund and execute such projects and activities in our small town. Westmeath is a special place with a strong culture of solidarity, and we pray for this passion to carry on for many years to come."

The Township also assisted with accessing water for flooding and donated the use of a portable toilet, located on the grounds for the winter months.

Mayor Moore also said "The project has been overwhelmingly successful and brought forward many willing and new volunteers in the community. We also feel it is important to keep people active during these times. We are proud of the people and the support of the Township."

FAMILY NAMES by Bob Grylls

While picking blueberries at the Blueberry Ranch last summer, I was talking to a couple also picking. They lived on Greenwood Road, their last name was Green, and the gentleman played fiddle in the Greenwood Band.

Many places have colours in their names. For instance Greenland, the Red Sea, Yellowknife, Whitehorse, Baton Rouge, Black Bay, etc.

Top Ten Most Common Canadian Surnames

According to a recent study, the <u>most common</u> Canadian surname is **Li**. This name has a Chinese origin. It might mean "minister".

<u>Number two</u> is **Smith**, a surname popular in several countries. This name refers to the job of blacksmith.

<u>Number three</u> is **Lam**. This might be a variant of either the Chinese surname Lin, which means "forest", or the Chinese surname Lan, which may refer to a flower.

<u>Number four</u> is **Martin**. This name derives from the Latin first name "Martinus", which refers to the Roman god of fertility and war, who was named Mars.

<u>Number five</u> is **Brown**. This comes from the Old English or Old French word "Brun". It refers to a person with brown hair or a brown complexion.

Number six is Roy. It comes from the Old French word "rey", which means "king".

Number seven is Tremblay. It refers to someone who lived near a group of Aspen trees.

<u>Number eight</u> is **Lee**, (not to be confused with Li). This name comes from the Old English word "lea" and refers to a person who lives near a meadow.

<u>Number nine</u> is **Gagnon**. This name derives from the Old French word which meant "guard dog". <u>Number ten</u> is **Wilson**, which is a patronymic name that means "son of Will".

Glancing through the Westmeath telephone directory, it showed these names in order of popularity; Gervais, Bromley, Ethier, Martin, Lacroix, Bertrand and Dupuis.

The Beachburg directory had in order, Robinson, Hawthorne, Regier, Wright, Price, Vereyken and Wilson.
