

Truth and Reconciliation Day

The Westmeath & District Recreation Association held their first annual "tying of orange ribbons" to the ballfield fence in recognition of Canada's first day of Truth and Reconciliation.

Darren Shackleton, WDRA V-P made it happen despite all odds such as too late to advertise in the WDRA newsletter (only Facebook and a poster), and a shortage of orange T-shirts which required Amazon for plain orange ones. Many thanks to Jessie Jessup who spent countless hours with her Cricket machine and designing our Shirts with logos, making multiple trips to various stores for materials. Jessie printed 10 shirts with the logos for committee members.

Despite all this Darren and the committee handled about 50 volunteers to celebrate our indigenous neighbours. Ribbons were handed out to the volunteers in groups of 10. If it wasn't for Catherine and John Terhune, who after tying on their share of ribbons, spent more than an hour helping cut ribbons. Students, Blaze and Solace Cameron, cut numerous ribbons also.

First on the scene was Barbara Brennan, who started tying ribbons immediately and I feel was the person who accomplished the most. There were others too with excellent numbers. Three of us tracking names but lost accuracy at the end but I estimate about 2.000 ribbons were tied onto the fence.

We appreciate all those who participated. Mayor Mike Moore, Reeve Cathy Regier and Councilor Neil Nicholson were participants. Names of those helped are listed but some were missed and a few with a first name only. I apologize ahead of time.

Several indigenous families took part in tying ribbons. Jerry Gervais, a member of the Metis of Ontario was there. He felt the Metis nation would be pleased this WDRA celebration.

Despite so many obstacles to encounter, we feel it was a real success for our first attempt. The WDRA was the only group in Whitewater Region to participate in this Truth and Reconciliation awareness event.
