BAUER FIRST SHIFT AND MUSKRAT MINOR HOCKEY

AT THE BEACHBURG AREA



Do you know someone who has a child who might be interested in trying hockey? Maybe they were hesitant because of tales of high registration costs, not sure if their kids will like it, confused over what equipment to buy and what sizes, or just do not want to commit to a full season of practices, games and tournaments......Well Bauer and Hockey Canada have a new program to try to address these concerns. Its the Bauer First Shift program and Muskrat Minor Hockey was one of the 150 associations across Canada selected by Bauer to host the Bauer First Shift program for up to 30 kids from our greater community. It is an excellent program designed for kids ages 6-10 who have never tried minor hockey through Hockey Canada before. Bauer will provide head to toe equipment (everything! - valued at about \$700) sized to fit each child and Muskrat Minor Hockey Association provides six one hour sessions before Christmas and an option for another six sessions after Christmas plus the coaching staff. Sessions will be one hour long, on six consecutive Saturdays at the Beachburg Arena and led by our program instructor Stan Keon. Cost is \$200 for this excellent program, but if money is a challenge please contact me and we can look into sponsorship from a variety of sources across our community. We will be starting Oct 11th with introductory meeting and sizing all the equipment and then we will be on the ice starting Oct 22nd. We are already at the half full, so if you know anyone who might be interested please forward this link or have them call me for more information.
